




10 FACTS ABOUT TURKEYS

Fold your paper in half as shown and then open again.




Repeat step 5 on the left side of the model as shown.





Fold the outside corners into the center line and crease well.




Fold the dotted corners upwards along the dashed line as shown.

Then fold the same corner back down a third of the way down as shown.




Fold the top triangle forwards and tuck inside the folded sides as shown




Fold in half and rotate anti-clockwise.

Reverse fold the back and front sections as shown.



Fold the top corners downwards towards the centre, crease well and open again. Using the creases just created, bring the dotted corner outward to open the flap.




9 Use a **double reverse** fold on the dotted lines to form the head, and shape the beak downwards.

Bring the dotted corner downward using the creases created in step 4 as a guide.

Then fold the second dotted corner down toward the centre line and flatten.
